Conversion of the HSAB Billet Harvester to track drive...

The HSAB Billet Harvester for short rotation coppice (SRC) of salix and poplar produces billets of three different lengths, 15, 20 or 30cm. Billets are a storable fuel that dry exceptionally favourably as a biofuel, during storage. The same billets can also be used as cuttings for planting; reducing the planting cost, compared with conventional nursery cuttings, by 50%!!



During the summer, Henriksson Salix AB will convert the HSAB Billet Harvester to a track drive system, in order to achieve better “floatation” during wet harvest conditions. The “feeding”, will also be improved through an updated version of the vertical feed rollers and the elevator will be extended. The project is partly financed by the Swedish Energy Agency.
